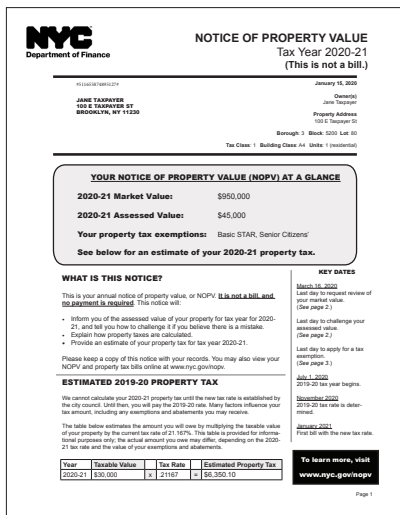

New York City Department of Finance**

- ➔ Save money on your property taxes by applying for exemptions
- ➔ Understand your NOPV
- ➔ Inquire about your market and assessed values
- ➔ Inquire about how to appeal your assessment



To apply for exemptions, please bring:

- ▶ Photo ID
- ▶ 2018 or 2019 tax returns or proof of income for all owners
- ▶ DD214 or honorable discharge papers (for veterans)
- ▶ Trust and life estate documents (if applicable)
- ▶ Stock certificate or maintenance statement (for coop owners)

Be sure to bring your Notice of Property Value (NOPV)
